## VILLAGE OF HOMER PUBLIC HEARING August 26, 2025

**PUBLIC HEARING #1:** 

Village of Homer will hold a public hearing on August 26,2025 at 6pm. The hearing will take place at the Town Hall in Homer at 31 N. Main St. The purpose of the hearing is to gather public comments on the Village of Homer's current Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing and Rehabilitation Program, Project #544HR315-23, which is funded in the amount of \$480,000.

The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and provides resources to eligible local governments for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the progress of the ongoing CDBG project. Comments related to the effectiveness of administration of the CDBG project will also be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

**PUBLIC HEARING #2:** 

A LOCAL LAW 1 of 2025 Approving the Code of the Village of Homer

In accordance with Subdivision 3 of § 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, the local laws, ordinances and certain resolutions of the Village of Homer, as codified and consisting of Chapters 1 through 228, are hereby approved, adopted, and enacted as the Code of the Village of Homer, hereinafter referred to as the "Code." The provisions of the Code, insofar as they are substantively the same as those of local laws, ordinances and resolutions in force immediately prior to the enactment of the Code by this local law, are intended as a continuation of such local laws, ordinances and resolutions and not as new enactments. This local law and the Code adopted hereby shall supersede and replace the 1991 Code of the Village of Homer, as amended and supplemented.
