RESOLUTION REGARDING MANDATORY TRAINING FOR ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS & PLANNING BOARD MEMBERS

WHEREAS Village Law Sections 7-712(7-a) and 7-718(7-a) provide that all Zoning Board of Appeals and Planning Board members, as well as alternate members of those boards, must complete a minimum of four hours of training each year; and
